WADE BOYD PROMOTED TO OVERSEE TIMBER, LUMBER OPERATIONS FOR LONGVIEW FIBRE COMPANY (NYSE: LFB)

LONGVIEW, WASH., MAY 10, 2004 - Promotion of Dr. Wade C. Boyd to Senior Vice President-Timber for Longview Fibre Company was announced today by Richard H. Wollenberg, president, chief executive officer and chairman of the board. Boyd replaces David L. Bowden, senior vice president-timber, who is retiring after 44 years of Longview Fibre service and many years of leadership in the timber industry.

Wollenberg said, "Boyd's responsibilities include the management of nine company tree farms in the Pacific Northwest totaling approximately 585,000 acres of timberlands. He will oversee our Sustainable-Forestry program; the staff of forest-management professionals; log sales; our Leavenworth, Wash., wood products plant, and other contracted lumber production." Boyd reports to Wollenberg, and is based at the company's Longview, Wash., timber offices.

Boyd will continue to represent Longview Fibre in various forest-industry matters. Currently, he is on the board of directors of the American Forest Resources Council. He is a past president, and served on the executive committee and board of trustees of Washington Forest Protection Association. Boyd was one of the forestry leaders participating in the lengthy Timber-Fish-Wildlife process that evolved into the landmark natural-resources protection legislation, Forests & Fish, that was passed by the Washington Legislature recently. He also has served on the boards of the Intermountain Tree-Nutrition Cooperative and IFA Nurseries, and is a member of Society of American Foresters.

Boyd has more than three decades working in forestry management and in the field in the private and public sectors in the Pacific Northwest and South. He also has taught forestry at the college level.

He was promoted in 1996 to vice president-timber for Longview Fibre, and is an assistant secretary of the Company. Boyd joined Longview Fibre in 1981 to manage the Chelan Tree Farm in Central Washington. He was promoted to assistant manager of the Company's timber department in 1989, transferring from Leavenworth to Longview.

Before Longview Fibre, Boyd began his career as a forester in southern Oregon in the Rogue River National Forest, and continued working for the U.S. Forest Service on the Southern Forest Survey as associate mensurationist stationed in New Orleans, La. He returned to the Pacific Northwest and was a forestry instructor at Wenatchee, Wash., Valley College for ten years, and later was an assistant professor in Washington State University's forestry department. He also was a consultant forester for several years.

Boyd has a B.S. degree in forest management from University of Arkansas-Monticello, a Masters degree in forest bio-metrics from Duke University, and a Ph.D. in forest management from University of Washington. He was a gunnery officer in the U.S. Army. He and his wife Beth have two grown children, both of whom are forestry professionals in the industry working as an operations forester and a research forester. They have two grandchildren.
